Tooth profiles

Straight toothing



For cutting across the fibres

Tooth-point hardening





For cutting across as well as along the fibres

Three phase toothing



For cutting across as well as along fibres. With three edges that give faster sawing and a cleaner cut.

Handsaws with hardened tooth points have 6 to 8 times longer wear time than ordinary teeth.

Hardened tooth points should however not be filed.
